



Admission Notice into Postgraduate Courses (Session : July-2010)

Applications are invited from Medical / Dental graduates in the prescribed form, who fulfill the pre-requisites mentioned below for admission into **MTM, Diploma & FCPS Part-I Courses (Courses of BCPS)** in the Faculties of Medicine, Surgery, Basic Medical Sciences & Dentistry **and** different **MD / MS & M. Phil** courses under postgraduate Residency Programme in the **Faculty of Basic Medical Sciences at the Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University, Dhaka, Bangladesh.**

(I) MTM (Master in Transfusion Medicine) [Course Duration 1 (one) year] :

One year training as Medical Officer or as a House Appointment in a Blood Transfusion Centre or in the Department of Transfusion Medicine (Blood Transfusion) of a teaching hospital as recognized by the Public Universities or BSMMU for the purpose.

General Pre-requisites for Application :

- Pre-requisites for admission:
 - must have MBBS/BDS/equivalent degree, b) one year internship, c) completion of one year after internship, d) BMDC registration.
- Candidates serving in BCS (Health) Cadre, Govt. Projects, BSMMU & Autonomous bodies have to complete minimum two years of service before being eligible for deputation / study leave as per existing rules of those organizations. So, candidates of those organizations who will not have completed minimum two years of service on 30th June, 2010 for the candidates of group - A and on 31st August, 2010 for the candidates of group - B, are advised not to apply.
- Candidates serving in BCS (Health) Cadre, Govt. Projects & Autonomous bodies should apply through proper channel with an advance copy.
- Candidates serving in BSMMU can apply for admission into the above mentioned courses. They will have to apply through proper channel and the rules of the University will be applicable for them. Research Assistants working in various departments of the university can apply in their own discipline only.
- The applicants should not be above 45 years of age on 30th June, 2010 for the candidates of group - A, and on 31st August, 2010 for the candidates of group - B.

6. Written (MCQ) admission test will be held on a total mark of 100, Time: 90 Minutes, Cut off mark : 50.
7. The prescribed form is to be collected from **Pubali Bank Ltd., Shahbagh Avenue Model Branch, Dhaka on Payment of Tk. 2000/=** (non-refundable) to the **BSMMU Examination Fund, SB A/C No. 13692** (White form for Govt., Autonomous & Private candidates, Pink form for BSMMU candidates, Yellow form for foreign candidates).

Other Information for the Candidates of Residency Programme:

- a) The MD / MS/M. Phil courses will be a Residency training programme in which the selected candidates will be required to undertake laboratory & clinical work in the specified departments/specialties. The courses will be of structured, e.g., to handle various types of specimens & to see patients, to do or to attend the diagnostic procedures and also to attend in lecture, seminar, clinical and journal club meeting as per curriculum of the discipline. Relevant teachers will monitor these activities through log book maintained by the candidates / other methods of supervision maintained as per curriculum. Private candidates will be paid an honorarium during the actual period of training in residency programme.
- b) After getting admission into the residency programme, candidates will not be allowed to be involved with Private Practice. If proved in any way, the candidates shall be bared from continuing the course.**
- c) The academic classes for the students of Residency Programmes for the faculty of Basic Medical Sciences will commence from 1st September, 2010.

ADDITIONAL PREREQUISITES & INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES OF DIPLOMA COURSES :

- ❖ The academic classes for the students of Diploma Courses will commence from 1st July, 2010.

ADDITIONAL PREREQUISITES :

- A. **D. Orth. (Diploma in Orthopaedics & Traumatology) :** Six months residential training in General Surgery in a hospital as recognised by the University of Dhaka / Chittagong / Rajshahi or BSMMU after one year internship.
- B. **DA (Diploma in Anaesthesiology) :** One year full time hospital appointment in Anaesthesiology under a qualified anaesthetist and 6 (six) months training as a House Physician or House Surgeon in the department of Medicine (General), Surgery (General) or Obstetrics and Gynaecology of a hospital as recognized by the University of Dhaka / Chittagong / Rajshahi or BSMMU for the purpose.
- C. **D. Card (Diploma in Cardiology) :** One and half year full time residential training out of which 6 (Six) months in Internal Medicine and one year in Cardiology from a hospital recognized by the University of Dhaka / Chittagong / Rajshahi or BSMMU for the purpose.
- D. **DCP (Diploma in Clinical Pathology) :** One year training in a Medical College or Institute in Pathology and/or Microbiology as recognised by the University of Dhaka / Chittagong / Rajshahi or BSMMU for the purpose.
- E. **DDV (Diploma in Dermatology & Venereology) :** One year training in the indoor-patient or out-patient department of Skin and Venereal Diseases in a hospital as recognised by the University of Dhaka / Chittagong / Rajshahi or BSMMU for the purpose.
- F. **DDS (Diploma in Dental Surgery) :** BDS degree of University or its equivalent registered Under Bangladesh Medical & Dental Council & any of the following .
 - i) One year full-time hospital-practice as a House Staff (in addition to internship) in the Dental Department of a hospital of a Thana/Upazila Health Complex as recognized by BMDC.
 - ii) One year lectureship in a Dental College/Institute as recognized by the University of Dhaka / Chittagong / Rajshahi or BSMMU.
 - iii) One year training in any field of Dentistry in a foreign Dental Institute or Hospital as recognized by BMDC.
- G. **DGO (Diploma in Obstetrics & Gynaecology) :** One year full time residential training in an Obstetrics and Gynaecology unit and 6 (six) months continuous residential job in a Medical / General Surgical or Paediatrics unit (or additional six month's training in Obstetrics & Gynaecology) as recognized by the University of Dhaka / Chittagong / Rajshahi or BSMMU for the purpose.
- H. **DLO (Diploma in Otolaryngology) :** One year house appointment in the department of ENT diseases and 6 (six) months full time hospital appointment as a House Surgeon or a House Physician in a General Surgical or Medical unit recognised by the University of Dhaka / Chittagong / Rajshahi or BSMMU for the purpose.
- I. **DO (Diploma in Ophthalmology) :** One year house appointment in the department of Ophthalmology and 6 (Six) months continuous full time residential training in either Medicine or General Surgery in the hospital as recognized by the University of Dhaka / Chittagong / Rajshahi or BSMMU for the purpose.

Documents to be submitted with application :

- ❖ Three copies of recent passport size photographs (to be pasted with gum in the specified places).
- ❖ Original certificate of present government service (with signature of the controlling officer and the seal of his office).
- ❖ **Attested photocopies of the following :**
 - (i) SSC or equivalent certificate containing the date of birth.
 - (ii) MBBS/BDS/Postgraduate Diploma Certificate/ equivalent Degree.
 - (iii) Internship certificate.
 - (iv) Mark sheets of the final MBBS/BDS/equivalent degree.
 - (v) BMDC permanent registration certificate
 - (vi) Order of first posting in the government service (where applicable)
 - (vii) Appointment letter & Joining report at the first place of posting in Government Service/BSMMU/Autonomous bodies (where applicable)
 - (viii) Last deputation order (where applicable)
 - (ix) Money receipt along with application.

Admission eligibility for Foreign Students & Documents to be submitted with application:

- i) Foreign students are to collect NOC ('No Objection Certificate') from their respective Mission / Embassy in Bangladesh and other relevant organizations and WHO.
- ii) Their MBBS/BDS/equivalent Certificate / degree will be required to get equivalency recognition from BMDC (Bangladesh Medical & Dental council).
- iii) They must have an **IELTS Band score of minimum 5.0. IELTS will not be required for the candidates completed courses in English Medium.**
- iv) Internship certificate of one year.
- v) Completion of one year after internship.
- vi) Their training certificates (if any) received from foreign institutions will have to be accepted by the departmental committee of this University.
- vii) They should not be over 45 years of age on 30th June, 2010 for the candidates of Group-A & on 31st August, 2010 for the candidates of Group - B.
- viii) Application form together with the above documents are to reach the office of the Controller of Examinations of BSMMU on or before 31st May, 2010.
- ix) All eligible candidates shall have to appear before the interview board of the respective department of the University.

The prescribed form is to be collected from Web site www.bsmmu.org & Pubali Bank Ltd., Shahbagh Avenue Model Branch, Dhaka on payment of BDT. 2000.00 or US\$ 30.00 (non refundable) to the BSMMU Examination Fund SB A/C No. 13692.

General Information :

- ❖ The application with the above documents is to reach the office of the **Controller of Examinations, Room No. 105 (1st floor), Block 'B', Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University, Shahbagh, Dhaka-1000 by 06th May, 2010, before 2.30 PM.**
- ❖ No candidate can apply for more than one course.
- ❖ Candidates already in any postgraduate **course can not apply.**
- ❖ No Government, autonomous & BSMMU candidates will be considered for application within two years of completing deputation/service on or before 30th June, 2010 for the candidates of Group -A & 31st August 2010 for the candidates of Group -B unless she/he passed that course examination and is now seeking a deputation for post-graduation in a related subject.
- ❖ Only eligible candidates will be issued **Admit Card** for the written Admission Test.
- ❖ Candidates providing inaccurate information whenever detected will be rejected.
- ❖ There will be no '**Carry On**' system in the residency Courses.
- ❖ Admission and examination procedures for MTM & Diploma courses and MD / MS / M. Phil residency courses will be followed as per rules & regulations approved by the syndicate from time to time.

- ❖ **Admit Cards are to be collected by the candidates in person from the office of the Controller of Examinations, Room no.-105 (1st floor), Block-B, BSMMU, Shahbagh, Dhaka, during working hours (9 AM to 2.30 PM) from 17-05-2010 to 20-05-2010.**
- ❖ **Written (MCQ) Test will be held on 21-05-2010, Friday from 09.30 A.M. to 11.00 AM, BUET (Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology) Campus, Dhaka.**
- ❖ **No candidate will be allowed to enter into the examination hall without admit card. Each candidate is requested to carry a ball-point pen, a 2B pencil, good quality eraser and a pencil-sharpener to the examination hall even in off mode.**
- ❖ **No candidate will be allowed to enter into the examination room 15 minutes after the examination starts.**
- ❖ **Mobile phones will not be allowed in Examination hall.
